ENERGY CONSERVATION



All common areas utilize LED energy efficient lighting. Lighting is controlled with motion sensors and schedules.

The facilities feature clerestories and skylights in certain areas to allow for natural light, reduce energy usage, and to create heating and cooling efficiency through heat retention / release based on local weather.

HVAC system utilizes controlled scheduling to conserve energy. Meeting spaces are turned to "off" when not in use. Outside air can be permitted for appropriate temperature setting based on outside temperature.

All kitchen appliances are certified energy efficient.

Civic Plaza features solar pagodas that provide shade and power.

WATER CONSERVATION



Public restrooms utilize low flow touchless faucets and touchless toilet / urinal valves.

Landscaping utilizes low flow drip heads and operates light watering schedules.

All hand sinks and sprayers in the kitchen utilize low flow faucets.

REDUCTION OF PAPER / PLASTIC



Food and Beverage operations source sustainable and / or recycled products whenever possible.

The property sources FSC-certified paper products whenever possible.

The facilities feature 18 water fountains and 10 refill stations to minimize the need for plastic water bottles.

RECYCLING / FOOD WASTE



The facilities participate in a robust recycling program with the City of Albuquerque Solid Waste.

Food and Beverage participates in a food waste program with Adelante Desert Harvest Food Rescue Program to donate over-run or surplus food.
